



Storage Containers

As pictured above, two acrylic compact disc holders make neat and attractive storage for the Language Works material. The clear containers are compartmentalized, each holding 30 booklets and lists. *You will need two to hold the entire set of 60 booklets and lists.*

These acrylic CD holders are available through *Amazon*. Product name is the **STORi Stackable Clear Plastic CD Holder - Holds 30 Standard CD Jewel Cases**. (Remember to order two.)

Note: The acrylic racks work best if placed in a stationary situation. (Since they are made for CDs, the bottom is partially open and the lists will drop through if the rack is lifted.)

Various solutions to this problem include:

- 1) Glue library pockets (acquired from teachers' stores) to the inside cover of each green booklet to hold the matching list.
- 2) Glue a piece of plexiglass or cardboard to the bottom of each rack.
- 3) Set the racks on a tray for mobility.
