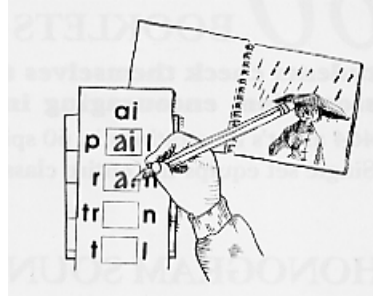


It's as easy as 1-2-3!

The Language Works Spelling Program provides the phonetic building blocks needed to read and spell. It allows students to work independently, checking themselves as they go! To begin, introduce the student to the sound (phonogram) at the top of the card. Do not look at the pictures yet. Then begin Step 1 below.

Step 1: Write in the windows

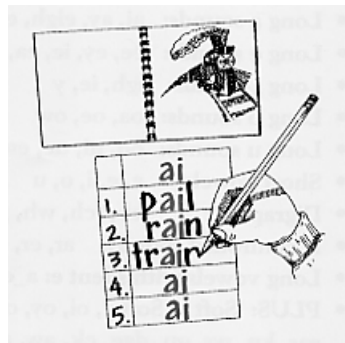
Set the list on the left side of your lined paper. Using a colored pencil, write the phonogram in the first window. Sound out the word. Then look at the first picture in the book. Did you get it right? Continue one word at a time. This is fun!



Step 2: Complete each word

This time, you will be working on the right side of the paper. Fill in each window again, checking with each picture as you go. Then, place the list aside (turn it over so you can't see the words).

Now, you will use the pictures to help you complete each word. Using a regular pencil this time, look at the first picture and write the missing letters to finish the word. Work all the way down the list completing each word.



Then Self-Check

When finished, check your work by placing the list back up on the left side of the paper and comparing the two sides. Make corrections if needed. Good job!

Step 3: Test yourself

After some practice with the Word Games (shown on the Teacher's DVD) you will be ready to spell the words. Look at each picture in order to write each word.
